



# SAFE STORAGE & DISPOSAL OF CANNABIS PRODUCTS



## SAFE STORAGE

Safely storing cannabis lowers the chance of children and pets accessing it.

- Keep a list of the cannabis products in your home. In case of accidental ingestion, the Poison Control Center or medical professional may ask for it.
- Store cannabis products in their original containers.
- Keep cannabis in a secure and locked place.
- Store cannabis out of sight and reach of children and pets.
- Consider using a safe or lockbox with a combination lock or keypad to keep cannabis secure and children safe.

## SAFE DISPOSAL

Dispose of expired/unwanted cannabis and cannabis waste safely at home:

1. Remove cannabis from its packaging.
2. Crush or chop up cannabis.
3. Put the crushed cannabis in an empty container.
4. Mix something unappealing with the crushed cannabis.
5. Cover the container and seal it with tape.
6. Throw the sealed container away in the regular trash.

### IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

Call the CT Poison Control Center at 1-800-222-1222 or your child's doctor right away if you think your child might have ingested cannabis. The Poison Control Center can also help if your pet has eaten cannabis.

Remember: Don't flush! Keep cannabis out of the public water supply.
